Son of George and Helen Millin; husband of Bessie E. Millin, of 255, Maryland St., Winnipeg, Canada. Native of Brixton, London. Grave Ref. A. 152.

TAYLOR, Lieutenant, HAROLD RICHARD, Surrey Yeomanry (Queen Mary's Regiment). attd. 77th Coy., Machine Gun Corps, Died of wounds 17 March 1917. Age 27. Son of Elizabeth Alice and the late Theophilus Taylor, of Roslin Villa, Richmond Rd., Taunton. Grave Ref. D. 660.

SUTTON, Private, HEDLEY MACKNEY, 45478, "A" Sqdn., Surrey Yeomanry (Queen Mary's Regiment). Killed in action 28 August 1917. Age 26. Son of Arthur Hedley Sutton and Katharine Jane Sutton, of "The Laurels," Park Hill Rd., Ewell, Surrey. Grave Ref. II. E. 1.

"Transylvania" for which the award of the Board of Trade Silver medal for saving life at sea was posthumously made. Son of Laura Charlotte
