Aug 17th	13:00 Approximately 20 bombs dropped on Tangmere by 24 planes believed Junkers 8. Fierce air battle over 3425, large column of black smoke over Tangmere.
Aug 23rd	New O.P. constructed at Trundle 313305. O.Ps at Stoke Clump and Bow Hill withdrawn.
Aug 27th/28th	11:00 Gas Spray Exercise. Whole of the Battalion took part in the two days.
Aug 28th	15:00 Gen. Sir Richard Foster K.C.B. C.M.GD.S.O., Col. of the Regiment inspected the Battalion (see attached letter of congratulation).
