**June NEW MILTON**

Jun 1st - 19th Work continued on defences on Bn. front. Bn. attended Demonstrations etc., and carried out Weapon Training on local ranges.

Jun 20th Advance Parties of 1/6 Surreys proceeded to Blighmont Barracks, Southampton.

Jun 21st 16:00 7 Wilts. relieved 6 Surreys in area New Milton.  
17:00 Bn. proceeded to Blighmont Barracks, Southampton by march route.  
23:45 Bn. H.Q. established at Blighmont Barracks.

**SOUTHAMPTON**

Jun 22nd 01:30 Many land mines dropped during enemy air action. No casualties sustained in Bn. Bn. took to slit trenches for first time since bad raid in December 1940.
