Jul 3rd	Battalion Church Parade.
Jul 4th	Major L.H.B. Lethbridge relinquished duties of 2 i/c on transfer. Major W.C.R. Nash was appointed 2 i/c.
Jul 6th	A lecture was given in the N.A.A.F.I. Institute to all members of the M.T. section and motorcyclists in the Battalion by a member of Norton Motors Ltd.
Jul 12th	Battalion proceeding to Castle Howard for Combined Operations Training in conjunction with tanks.
Jul 19th	Battalion returned from Castle Howard.
Jul 20th	Major Heath of Records Dept. visited the Battalion to examine its records and expressed satisfaction.
Jul 21st	Commanding Officer attended a conference on Ex. PUSSYFOOT.
Jul 22nd - 24th	Div. Ex. PUSSYFOOT. Battalion H.Q. took part in the exercise.
Jul 23rd	The band of the I.T.C. The Duke of Cornwall's Light Infantry visited the Battalion and gave a concert. The Commanding Officer proceeded to Edinburgh to sit on an O.C.T.U. Board.
