Feb 1st	Capt AWF Paskins (Adjutant) admitted to 13 General Hospital. Lt JE Hatt-Cook assumed duties of Adjutant. 1415: Warning Order for exercise 'Wedding Bells' issued.	
Feb 2nd	1900: Bn moved out for exercise 'Wedding Bells'. 2330: Bn arrived Concentration Area, dug in and waited for transport, which had taken separate route and was crossing desert by compass bearing. Capt FC Ridger admitted to 13 General Hospital.	
Feb. 3rd	Bn stayed in Concentration Area all day. Comd Offr went out with Recce party. 1400: "O" Group met.
